Dear Parents and members of our local community

COVID-19 Trace, Track and Protect

We have been informed of a second positive Covid-19 test relating to an individual who attends Ysgol Greenhil. **We can confirm this is directly related to the case that you were informed about on Friday 2nd October.**

Following guidelines, individuals identified as being in 'close contact' (as defined by Public Health Wales - Trace, Track and Protect) have been directed to self-isolate for 14 days. Parents of all those concerned have been contacted. Parents and carers of other children, do not need to contact the school to find out if their child has been affected.

We continue to work with Pembrokeshire County Council, Public Health Wales and Hywel Dda University Health Board to ensure that all possible precautionary measures are in place, to minimise risk of transmission of the virus. This includes a deep clean of classrooms and communal areas of school by trained staff. School transport bus and coaches are thoroughly cleaned after each journey and deep cleaned weekly.

Again Pembrokeshire County Council, Public Health Wales and Hywel Dda University Health Board have been swift in their response in support of the school and our community. For which we are grateful.

We would like to remind everyone of the importance of following *Public Health Wales guidance* regarding social distancing, good hand hygiene and the proper wearing of face coverings. PHW guidance <https://gov.wales/protect-yourself-others-coronavirus>. Following this guidance will benefit our whole community.

We will continue to support those who are being required to self-isolate as a precautionary measure so they can continue with their learning.

The school is in regular contact with those who have tested positive and we are pleased and reassured they are not experiencing significant symptoms and make good progress in terms of their recovery. We wish them well and a speedy return to full health.
